1. Rationale

- 1.1 The school defines the school's curriculum vision with the *HVA Curriculum Part 1: The vision*. The purpose of this document is to clarify the vision for children as Artists.

- 2.2 Our approach will:
- Teach and develop children's artistic skills.

- 2.4 There will be opportunities to develop techniques in sculpture, print and textiles.
- 2.5 There will be opportunities to learn about the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers, describing the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines, and making links to their own work.
- 2.6 Opportunities to develop as artists will be explicitly taught, usually within a familiar context.
- 2.7 Pupils' art will be celebrated through display in school and beyond.
