From this date on, our SENCo, Mrs Dexter will contact nurseries to identify the special educational needs or disabilities (SEND) for children.

### **Stay and Play**

#### **Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July at 2:15pm**

We are hosting a stay and play in our school hall all for all new families and their children joining us in September. This will be an opportunity to meet some of our school staff members and for children to play alongside new friends.

### **Picnic Lunch**

#### **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July 12:00 - 1:00 pm**

We are inviting all new parents (up to 4 adults per family) and children to join all the current Haywood Village children and staff in a picnic at the school. Families will need to bring their own picnic.

### **When will my child start school?**

All reception children will be in school full time from Monday 16<sup>th</sup> September. However, we have decided to arrange our transition days from Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> September according to the age group of the children:

- Younger starters: April – August born
- Older starters: September – March born
- SEND children: The school will be made aware by nurseries/pre-schools of those pupils who have been identified as having special educational needs and/or disability (SEND).
